STILL STANDING UP FOR THOSE LEFT BEHIND

How does a social service agency like JFS measure impact? It's a question we hear from constituents and Board members, donors and foundation leaders and it's a challenging question to answer.

We can and do track all the pertinent numbers— client visits in homecare, test scores at Framingham's Wilson School, visits to our in-house food pantry— to name just a few. Yet none of these measures can provide a cumulative understanding of the impact of our services and programs within the Metrowest community.

This year we've begun a multi-year program to devise and implement a performance measurement and management system that will function as both a planning and evaluation tool. It will be used across the entire agency to answer the questions, "What works?" and "How can it be changed if it doesn't?"

Many clients come to us when they are in crisis. Using this new system, we will assess their needs on a vulnerability scale that considers housing status, monthly expenses, financial resources, employment, and a list of individual needs and requirements. The scale begins with housing as the key element (homeless or housing in jeopardy) and lists four transitional steps on the way to secure affordable housing. The same tiered measurements are applied to all the other areas of concern. Stable housing, employment and savings determine success.

It's a complicated process. There are many issues to consider, many complexities to address and many steps to implement. The goal is to have this new effort fully in place across JFS by 2017. We will continue to update you on progress as we, our volunteers, staff and supporters work to better serve the 4,800 Metrowest residents who turn to us each year for assistance.



"It's always about housing," says Diana O'Brien,
Director of **Family Assistance** for JFS. "If they have
stable housing, we can work out the rest. We can
help with transportation and food and finding
work." Diana's clients this year included a woman
in her fifties who had been couch-surfing with
friends and family, another in her sixties facing
imminent eviction, a pregnant mother of three
living in a motel.

"Most new clients are near crisis," she continues.

"They need immediate help. Once we can get them someplace stable to live, we keep working to move them up the continuum until they can become self-sustaining."





"There's a new face of poverty in the suburbs. We see clients, professionals who've worked for the same company for over twenty years. Suddenly they're laid off and they don't have a clue about how to look for work in the 21st century."

Beth Squires is a Career Navigator for **Ready for Success**, a joint effort of JFS, CJP and the Jewish Vocational Service to help mid-life job seekers find work. "Our clients are vulnerable," she says. "They are not yet destitute, but they haven't looked for work or interviewed in years. They need resume support, interview practice and networking help. They need to learn how to use LinkedIn.

"I help to find the resources they need to be successful and give them the confidence they need to get back in the fight and find that next job."

"Our **Chapter Girls** loved 'Ola Shakes It Up," says Manager of Youth, Immigrant and Volunteer Services, Sarah Roth. The fifth grade book group, led by four trained mentors who are all members of the JFS Board, met weekly throughout the school year.

Girls read assigned pages, and then used the meeting time to discuss what they'd read. Skill building focused on content and comprehension; mentors reinforced the pleasure and importance of reading.

Chapter Girls was added this year to the JFS **Reducing Achievement Gaps** program at Framingham's Wilson School. Third graders participated in **All Stars**, and fourth graders in **Math Academy**. Both curricula continue to be modified to align with the school's goals for the International Baccalaureate Program that sets intellectual and social goals for students.

And a growing number of Wilson School parents are participating in **Parent University**, an adult-focused program run in partnership with Mass Bay Community College to help parents help their kids learn and further their own adult career goals.

"Volunteers are the heart of **Patient Navigator** and the key to its success," says JFS Manager of Program Operations, Amanda Coughlin. This year, 41 volunteers, who each completed 10 hours of training, accompanied 231 seniors to 425 medical appointments. Patient Navigator participants are from both the Jewish and broader community and include many Spanish, Chinese and Russian-speaking clients.

"We're putting the Jewish community on the radar of young families," says Malka Young, JFS Director of Community Impacts. Weekly playgroups at JFS form the core of extensive outreach that includes meetups at playgrounds, tot Shabbat and holiday celebrations and cooking classes. It's all about making the connection.

Through **Kesher**, JFS sponsors a rabbi's weekly visit to assisted living and nursing homes in Metrowest – a total of twelve each month – offering isolated seniors a chance to enjoy Shabbat and holiday observance. And **Kesher 13** engages the next generation as Bar and Bat Mitzvah candidates from five synagogues make regular visits to seniors in the community.
